PARENTING EDUCATION PROGRAMS

The Parent/Child Center, located at the SVI building, is our oncampus Parenting Education lab. Parents or caregivers can enroll in classes to help them implement developmentally appropriate practices in their daily lives. Parents spend a portion of the class time meeting with a Parent Education faculty member while their children are led by an earlychildhood teacher; adults also interact with children and assist the teacher in the preschool setting.

The Parent/Child Center's mission is to help families connect with one another, to support parenting and family development, and to share information pertaining to children and families.



Students can register for classes at Seattle Central College. Classes are \$140.25 for the quarter.

Please note that classes are held at Seattle Vocational Institute but you must register using the class codes listed for each class at the Seattle Central Registration Office.

Seattle Central College works with several cooperative preschools to provide parent and early childhood education for families in the Seattle area.

The preschools are very popular and provide a community of support for children and their families.

Parents gain knowledge in a variety of parenting techniques and experience in community leadership.

COOPERATIVE PRESCHOOLS

Seattle Central College is currently affiliated with 7 different cooperative preschools. Each school is operated independently, each as a separate non-profit organization with its own board of directors. Schools are run by a skilled preschool teacher, the children's parents, and a parent educator from SCC.

Teachers plan and implement a developmentally appropriate curriculum. Parents assist in the classroom and perform administrative duties. Parent educators advise teachers and help parents build parenting skills.
